SPRINT MAXX PEA/OAT FORAGE MIXTURE

Sprint Maxx is a forage blend of Haywire Brand Oats and Stockade Brand Peas. It produces high yields of high quality forage in dairy and beef areas throughout the northern United States and Canada. Sprint Maxx provides a quick source of forages within 60 days of planting and can be used as a nurse crop to establish alfalfa or it can follow winter wheat or sweet corn if planted within the first 2 weeks of August.

AGRONOMIC RECOMMENDATIONS

- Seedbed - A good seedbed is essential for maximum seed / soil contact. A firm seedbed enhances the opportunity for a good plant stand
- Seeding Rate - 120 lbs/acre with underseeding or 150lbs /acre without underseeding
- Seeding Depth - 1/2 to 1 inch deep with rolling or packing providing improved emergence
- Seeding Date - Seed as early as soil conditions allow in spring
- Fertility - Fertilize according to soil tests, keeping a balanced micro nutrient program
- Harvest Tips - Sprint Maxx is ready to harvest in 55-70 days, or early boot stage
