### GRAZEMASTER

GRAZEMASTER is not a ryegrass, it is a leafier winter rye forage that has excellent cold tolerance. When compared to VNS Rye it is higher in forage quality, containing higher protein and superior digestibility that is higher in energy.

### KEY CHARACTERISTICS

- Excellent producer of leafy forage from September through May.
- Widely adaptable. Results have been excellent throughout the South.
- Very cold tolerant and highly suitable in the Mid-Atlantic and Northeast.
- Grazemaster is leafier than many other strains of rye. Better leaf quality results in a higher quality forage, containing higher protein and calcium with better palatability.
- Grazemaster is very versatile - it performs equally well with beef, milk and sheep operations to grazing, silage, greenchop and haying.
- Rotates well with summer cash crops and forage crops. Can be interseeded into existing pastures.
- Excellent regrowth following close grazing or cutting.
