



AESCHYNOMENE

DESCRIPTION

 A warm season legume which grows 3' - 8' tall. Grows best where adequate moisture is present. Produces very high feed value (19% protein). Ideal and palatable for cattle, goats, sheep and wildlife consumption. Grows well with Bahia Grass or by itself.
 Aeschynomene will reseed if planted in subtropical climates. Plant during warm season when adequate moisture is present.
 Nematode resistance which is important for southern forage supplements.

Seeding Rate ______ 10-12 lbs./ac (hulled seed)
Seeding Date _____ April - June

To insure higher rate of germination seed when soil has reached adequate moisture.
